

Fantasy Play Activities

Bus Stop

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Materials Needed:

None! A bench or three chairs can be used but this game can also be played standing so no materials are necessary

How to Play:

3 players participate at a time. You start with one person sitting at "the bus stop" and then the next player comes and joins them. The purpose is for each player to take on any role they chose. At any time a player can "get on the bus" and leave the bus stop. It's a type of improv for the kids to engage in. At any time you can jump in as a new person at the bus stop and take on any role you want.

Adaptations:

This game can be played by more or less people. Adding people gives players more time to think of their next role while taking players away forces the players to be on their feet because they will have to think on the fly about what character they will be next.

The Animal Kingdom

Materials Needed:

None! Players could incorporate props if they wanted or thought it would help them get into character.



How to Play:

Ideally two to three kids play this game together. You all chose an animal, act that animal out and play as that animal interacting with each other until you can guess what the other players are.

Adaptations:

Adding players can make the game last longer. In this version of the game, once someone guesses your animal you change what animal you are so you can continue interacting with all the players.
